



Admissions Statement

Vantage CE Academies Trust is the Admissions Authority for all of its constituent academies; the Trust board approves admissions policies for all academies and delegates decisions over admissions to the Local Advisory Boards at each school.

Local Advisory Boards will write their own school Admissions Policies and apply oversubscription criteria where necessary. The Trust board will ratify the Admissions Policy for each academy in the Trust annually.

All schools within the Trust write their own admission arrangements that clearly set out how children will be admitted, including the criteria that will be applied if there are more applications than places at the school. These admissions procedures are applied fairly and in line with legislation.

Admission arrangements within Trust academies aim to achieve full compliance with all relevant legislation and guidance. Their arrangements take account of the guidance provided in the School Admissions Code of Practice 2021, the School Admissions Appeals Code 2022 and the Equality Act of 2010 – they will not discriminate against any person in the arrangements and any decisions they make as to who is offered admission as a pupil.
